# ACCREDITATION OPENING HOURS

**June 8,9 and 10**

**8:30- 12:30 | 13:30 – 19:00**

**June 11 to 14**

**8:00 – 12:00 | 13:00 – 18:00**

The accreditation centre is located at the Regatta course, inside the public entrance on the left of the main building, when coming from the access road.

**All participants of the event must be accredited, since no access is granted to the venue without an accreditation pass. Please, note that you will not be accredited and the accreditation cards will not be given until you have a zero balance towards the Organising Committee.**

**Please note:** If accreditation card is lost, damaged or forgotten at the hotel and needs to be reprinted, a cost of 25 EUR per accreditation card will incur.

Acceptable methods of payment: cash (€), credit card (Visa, Eurocard / Mastercard)  
Payments made by credit card are subject to an additional 1.5% processing fee.

Team leaders and masters athletes are required to come alone to the Accreditation centre.

There will be a ticket waiting system, to avoid confusion and queues.

Upon arrival to the centre take your ticket and check the monitor for your number. There will be 3 tickets tolerance. Each ticket will be for one person only.

## **Accreditation process includes the following steps:**

In case your team would cause any damage to the rooms you are to pay for it on the spot. **Credit card deposit may be asked at the check in to cover these costs.**

## MEALS

Please bring your accreditation card for all meals.

Information for teams who have booked their accommodation outside the Organising Committee:

Participation fee will be charged from the day of your arrival at a cost of 40 EUR per person per day

Lunch can be provided at the venue for an additional fee of **20 EUR/person/day**.

There will be always 3 types of dishes available. Meat, Fish, and vegetarian. Any special requests must be sent in advance to **monica@canoportugal.com**

Drinking water will be provided during the whole access period from water dispensers [Clear water system]. Please, note that all team members will have a free BOTTLE provided by the OC. Reusable BOTTLES will be given at info desk. Please keep them until the end of the championships.

## DAILY TRANSPORTATION

A shuttle bus service will operate daily between the regatta course and the official hotels.

The Schedule, as well as lanes and routes will be published at information desk, official WhatsApp group and at each hotel as well as in the transportation office.

Please, note that the shuttle bus service is available exclusively for those who have booked accommodation directly with the Organising Committee.

All Buses will be seated only, so each bus has a specific limitation of persons to transport.

**Please follow the drivers' instructions and respect the way of each BUS. There will be a route VENUE-HOTELS and another route HOTELS-VENUE. Don't go in the BUS if that bus is not in the route you wish to use.**



## SECURITY & MEDICAL CARE

A medical centre will operate at the regatta course with doctor on duty, ambulance and first aid.

The Organising Committee is not responsible to cover your expenses in connection with hospital treatment, dental treatment or any other medical treatment exceeding the regular first aid/ambulance services. Those are to be covered by your medical insurance policy.

The OC provides lifeguard service on the water during the official training sessions and on race days. OC cannot guarantee to guard the whole water surface of the venue so please stay within the guarded areas, between 1000m and finish line on the main channel.

**During training days, there will be limited service of Water lifeguard, with just one boat on the Water and one ambulance at the venue.**

**During competition days, the resources will be 3 motorboats plus a jet ski and one ambulance. They will be on service 1h before and 30 minutes after each day schedule.**

Please keep in mind: The OC does not take responsibility for any accidents in areas outside the venue areas and outside the opening periods of the venue.

The Regatta centre will be a closed area with a 24h security staff and surveillance for the whole week of the Championships.

### VENUE WORKING HOURS

**Venue will be open every day in its regular schedule until 10/06. From 7:30 to 20:00**

During competition days venue will open 2 hours before the first race and closes 1 hour after the last race.

## OFFICIAL TRAINING SESSIONS

**08/06 to 10/06 From 08:00 - 12:00 | 14:00-18:00**

Outside this period training is possible but OC will not provide local lifeguard resources. During the official training sessions, athlete will be given opportunity to test the automatic start system. **Wednesday 10 June 10.30-11.30 1000m and 15.00-16.00 200m**





## TEAM QUARTERS AND AREAS

HOC will provide a total of 13 hangars for all countries competing at this competition. Each hangar will be occupied by a certain number of countries, with a maximum of 100 persons. Each hangar will be identified with a list of countries at the entrance.

Inside each hangar teams will find a TV LED screen with internal tv circuit to watch the competition, a cold-water dispenser, 220v power plug, Wi fi internet and limited number of tables and chairs [one table and at least 2 chairs per country. Wifi to be used is the Montemor2026-Public connection. Password is **Teams#2026**

Please take in consideration to respect others and share the space with all countries designated to your hangar.

All kayaks and canoes **MUST** be outside of the hangars, in the designated exterior boat racks. Any boats inside the hangars will be removed by OC at any moment. Please feel free to bring your own portable tent, that can be mounted in the back of the hangars(OUTSIDE), facing teams parking. [Keep in mind floor is asphalt and cannot be drilled.

OC will provide a special space for MASTERS in the far side of the hangars. Even being a shared zone and services between NFs and master's, we ask for all to respect the different areas.

## BOAT STORAGE

All boats will be stored at a designated area on the outside boat racks. Each rack will be marked by country name. The distribution of space will be done according to the nominal entries.

Once the boats are unloaded from the trailers, those need to be parked in a special parking area. Trailers are not permitted to go inside the Venue. Boats must be loaded from the main entrance. OC will provide a special space for Racks for MASTERS Boats in the far side of the hangars. We ask for all to respect the different areas.

## TRAILERS AND PARKING

HOC will provide a closed parking for teams and their car, vans and trailers. Special parking passes for vehicles will be given at the accreditation centre.

## TRAFFIC RULES DURING RACE DAYS

During the race day athletes are kindly requested to use the Returning channel to go to the start area. There are connection paths at 1100 and 600 meters. This channel can also be used for warming up before the race.

We advise all athletes not to use the returning channel between 1100 and 2000 meters, as it might be found with Water weed.

For cooling down, please use the Channel on the side of the hangars, next to the restaurant area.

## CYCLING PATH

The cycling path is located on the north side of the course [opposite to finish tower side]. The access is free to all coaches.

The road will not be fully controlled by OC as there are multi entrances along more than 2000 meters, so we advise caution during the use of this road.

## COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

ICF rules for will apply for these championships, except in the cases where PEU has different rules.





## ANTI-DOPING EDUCATION

For the ICF World Championships, ICF World Cups and ICF Ranking Races and **Continental Championships**, every athlete, coach and support personnel **MUST** pass the relevant anti-doping online course on the Anti-Doping Education Learning platform (ADEL) corresponding to their role.

Athletes entered in any ICF competition or **Continental championships** must complete the ICF's anti-doping education programme or equivalent before competing or risk being denied entry to the competition.

All start lists will be built with 2025 European Championships results for seeding. All progressions will follow ICF Canoe Sprint Rules, including the new system 2 for Finals as well as Paracanoe progressions rules.

In the online results page provided by memosoft, footage from technical drone will be available for each race, in the end of each session. Just look for the Drone icon inside the results page.

# ALTERATION OF ENTRIES AND WITHDRAWALS

In extraordinary circumstances, an application can be made to the Chief Official for the acceptance of late entries. Following the closure of the SDP system for Montemor entries, LATE ENTRY POLICY will be activated on June 2, 2026 00:00 CET.

Late Entry Policy will be applied until the deadline being Monday 8th June 18:00 UTC+1 as per below.

There will be 2 types of Late entry:

1. Late Nominal/SDP entry - which means new athletes not yet accredited for the Championships. Late SDP entries will incur a fee of 100 euros per athlete. Payments of the late entry fees will be accepted via credit card or cash in EURO at the Accreditation office.

2. Late event entry - which means athlete is already accredited for the Championships and/or entered in some other event. NO fee will be applied. BUT, it is the Chief Official's discretion to accept or decline a late entry. Please note there will be NO change of progression plans after the publication of the Preliminary start list as a result of late event entry. The request for late entry/withdrawal/crew change can be submitted via the following online form [HERE](#)

Only requests submitted until the deadline will be considered. After the deadline you need to contact the Chief Official directly.

**DEADLINE TO SUBMIT THE REQUESTS: LATE ENTRY: Monday 8th June, 18:00 UTC+1**

CREW CHANGES: Wednesday 10th June, 11:00 UTC+1.

1. Any athlete named in the final entry of his/her country may substitute in any other event.
2. Notification of alterations of the entries must be submitted via online form within pre-determined deadlines given above.
3. Chief Official may in exceptional circumstances accept late alterations. Late alterations must be given in a written form to the Chief Official at least one (1) hour before the first race of the morning or afternoon session.
4. The withdrawal of an entry is considered final and the same athlete/crew is not allowed to compete in any other events of the competition.
5. The withdrawal of an entry in an event without consequences is only permitted until five [5] days before the first day of the races (Saturday 6th June 2026);
6. In crew boats the names of the competitors MUST BE in order that they race in the boat. The first name at the top MUST BE the competitor at the front of the boat

## TEAM LEADERS' MEETING

The Team Leaders meeting will be held online, 1 week before the first day of competition, on Thursday 4th, at 19:00 CET. For the on-line meeting the Microsoft teams application will be used. Link to the meeting can be found [HERE](#).

One Meeting with Coaches and team leaders will be held at the venue on Friday 12th June at 12.00 at the Finish Tower, 2nd floor.

## OPENING CEREMONY

**When?** Wednesday, June 10 2026 17:00h

**Where?** Venue grand Stands.

All teams are kindly required to delegate two athletes to carry the national flag and name of your country! The duration of the ceremony will not exceed 45 min. The delegate of each country should be at 16:15 at the finish tower ground floor.

## PRE-RACE BOAT CONTROL

Pre-race boat control is a self-boat control.

All athletes are responsible to ensure the boats conform to the technical requirements for the Competition as per the rules.

Organising Committee will provide for boat control 1 certified weighing and measuring device which will be available from Monday 8 of June 2026 according to the venue opening hours. This will be near the restaurant area.

## BOAT AND PERSONAL NUMBERS

The personal numbers (BIBs) to be worn during the whole the competition can be collected by the team leaders at accreditation.

New bibs numbers will be given to those who lost it or forget it at the hotel. Those can be collected at finish tower, 3rd floor at Competition Committee.

The boat numbers will be given ONLY when boats are heading to the ID control. There will be a tent with volunteers to provide you the number for that race.

Boat numbers must be returned to the organisation by leaving them on the proper box, outside the exit pontoons or 2nd boat control.



## ATHLETE NAME AND COUNTRY CODE STICKERS

The country code stickers on the boats are **MANDATORY** for seniors and Paracanoe. It is the participating National Federations' responsibility to provide the stickers to their athletes. Please use this template provided by the ICF with the correct sizes and font. [Link Here](#)

There will be no possibility to print those at the venue.

## UNIFORM AND UNIFORMITY

The athletes must wear appropriate official clothing with easy identification of the nation they represent. Every athlete must compete in the team uniform submitted with the nominal entries by uploading a picture of their uniform before the entry deadline in SDP to the relevant section. A detailed guideline "How to add Uniforms - for National Federations" can be found on this [LINK](#).

In a crew boat there **MUST BE** uniformity among all athletes including: sleeve length, hats, headbands, undergarment, and spray covers. If used, spray covers **MUST BE** the same. The front athlete in K2 or K4 may compete without a spray deck. Sunglasses are optional. A computer system will be used to validate all entries. Athletes must present the accreditation card for confirmation of an entry.



## ID CONTROL

The competitors can embark only from the designated place before the competition where their boats, body numbers, boat numbers and accreditation cards are checked.

In crew boats uniformity will be checked too.

In crew boats there must be uniformity among all athletes including sleeve length, hats, headbands. If used, spray covers must be the same. Using the spray cover for the first competitor in the crew boat is optional. Glasses are optional.

ITOs will use a computer system to validate all entries. Athletes must present the accreditation card for confirmation of an entry.

In addition, competitor's equipment will also be checked for any foreign substances and forbidden devices. A boat or athlete may be equipped with a device which provides feedback on performance for use by television or event presentation. The same device may be used by the coach and athlete for analysis after a race. But in NO circumstances may the device be used to provide real time feedback to an athlete during a race. A device MUST be placed BEHIND the last athlete in the boat.

Any devices that ID Controller(s) do not know or understand can be removed.

## PRE-RACE PROCEDURE

Only athletes for the next race start will be allowed to enter the indicated starting areas 200-300m, 500-600m, and 1000-1100m. They will be called to the starting area 3-4 minutes before the start.

Once the boats enter the starting area they are forbidden to turn around and they need to paddle a straight line towards their assigned start boats.

Aligners will be placed at the beginning of the starting area – 300m, 600m, or 1100m to control the boats' flow.

Please advise athletes to follow the instructions from aligners, and do not enter the starting area if they are not called and they are not part of the following race.



## POST RACE BOAT CONTROL

After the race some boats will be selected by the Competition Committee for a post-race boat control.

A LED screen with the lane numbers called will be located after the finish line on a left-hand side on the ground. The screen will also show the race number and race description. The numbers presented may not represent the ranking order of that race.

Athletes must disembark onto the designated pontoon where their boat will go under control. Volunteers will help carrying the boats and clean them.

Apart from the screen the lane numbers will be called aloud. Please do not forget to control the weight of your boat before the race at the self-boat control. All devices must not be on a boat during post-race boat control (not included in boat weight).

## DOPING CONTROL

Athletes will be randomly selected for doping control conforming to the relevant regulations. Accreditation card is mandatory during the process. Chaperones will inform the selected Athletes at 2nd boat control and guide them through the full process.

## MEDAL AWARDING CEREMONY

To maintain the formality of the ceremony the athletes receiving medals MUST wear their national team uniform and proper footwear. No Flags, caps or sunglasses are allowed at the podium.

Medal ceremonies will start at their officially scheduled time. In case any athlete arrives late to the meeting point, ceremony will start by the schedule without him/her. Medal ceremony preparation area is on the finish tower ground floor. Volunteers will guide athletes from the 2nd boat control to this location.

We will ask all team leaders with athletes in the finals(A) to prepare uniforms and deliver them at the specific desk (check venue layout). Volunteers will take them from there to the Medal ceremony preparation area. This applies Only for the first 3, rest can be collected after official results at the same location.

In celebration of excellence, resilience, and the spirit of sport, each victory at the 2026 Paddle Europe Sprint, Paracanoe and Masters Championships will be honoured with a living tribute. As part of Paddle Europe's Sustainability Strategy, the Organising Committee has developed a unique environmental legacy project for both the venue and the medallists of these Championships. For every athlete who reaches the podium, a tree will be planted — a quiet yet powerful symbol of growth, strength and an enduring legacy.

Each medallist will receive a commemorative tree-shaped token made from recycled cardboard, featuring a unique identification number. Following the Championships, every numbered token will correspond to a tree planted in the athlete's honour, creating a lasting connection between sporting achievement and environmental responsibility.

In this way, the success of today's champions will continue to grow long after the final race, rooted in the same values of perseverance, commitment and renewal that define our sport.

## STREAMING & Commentators

The organizing committee informs all championship will be streamed. The LIVE BROADCAST BLOCKS ( A FINALS) in Planet Canoe Youtube channel under a pay wall. All rest will be streamed in Paddle Europe YT(free of charge).

A total of 12 + cameras will be used in the TV Setup as well as tv graphics.

Also, 3 announcers and commentators will be working during competition days.

We might ask for the participation of some guest during a limited period in each day. We kindly ask for your collaboration.

## GREEN ROOM

The Organizing Committee will photograph all participants, using green screen technology. ECA and HOC are investing to present each athlete and boat in a professional way and your involvement is more than appreciated. The goal is to present all paddlers during the race, in the TV graphics.

The main beneficiaries of this presentation will be the athletes, Your presence is very important for the promotion of our sport, for yourself and the country you represent! It takes only 10 seconds to do it. There will be no video recording, only a still picture.

If possible please come with your team racing uniform for a better presentation.

The green room is located in the same space as Pre race boat control in athletes area with opening hours 9:00-17:00, from 8-10 June, 2026.

Priority to athletes who did not took picture in 2025.

## VIP

Organizing committee will have a VIP area for guests. This service will be open from Friday to Sunday.

Only selected number of persons will have access to this area. It is located in the first floor of the new finish tower.

President' s of National Federations and Secretary general' s will be invited to this Area.

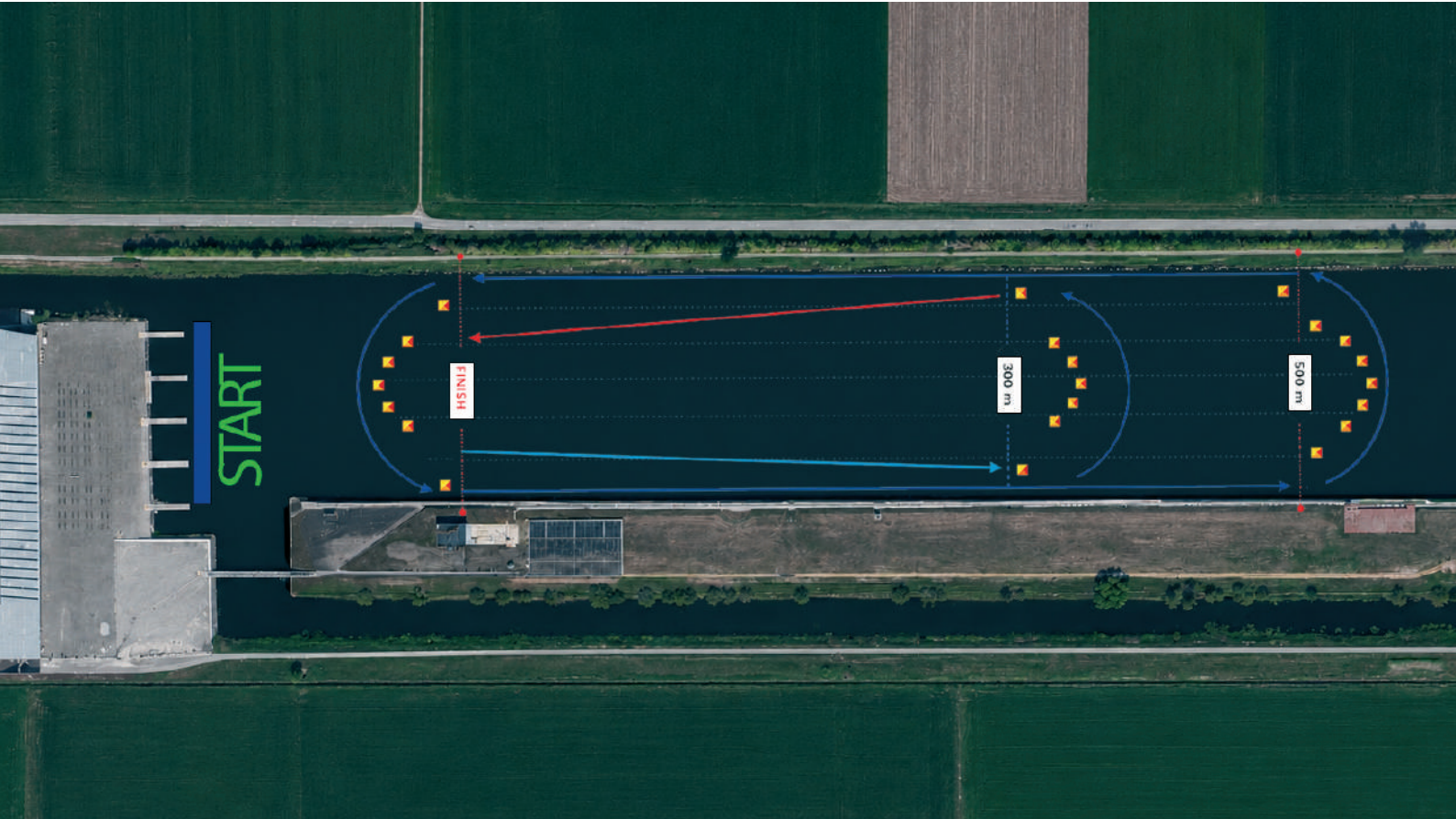
Team leaders will have no access to this area.

Daily VIP access can be bought at accreditation for 25€/day. Limited to 2 per team.



## 5000m Layout

The 5000 meters will be held in the classic 6 laps (1 long and 5 short) and no portage.



## PARACANOE CLASSIFICATION

Classification of paracanoe athletes will take place at the Regatta Course (please see the Venue map)-- between 8 and 9 June (Monday-Tuesday).
